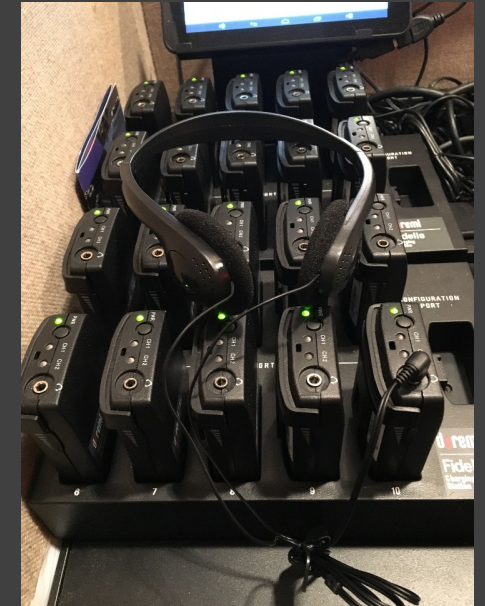
OMNIMAX[®] Theater: Access

- The OMNIMAX[®] Theater can be accessed by taking Elevator 2 on the north side of the Concourse to the 2nd floor.
- There is accessible seating at the top of the OMNIMAX[®] Theater.
- This is also the best seating for those with sensory or motion sensitivities.
- The theater also offers a universal restroom on second floor south.



OMNIMAX[®] Theater: Amenities

- Assisted listening, closed captioning and descriptive audio are offered for most, but not all, OMNIMAX[®] films.
- The OMNIMAX[®] Theater also has 10 pairs of earmuffs, handfuls of fidgets and a 5-lb. weighted blanket for guests to use.
- All tools available upon request.



Featured Exhibition: Entry

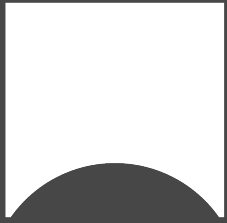
- Plenty of wide queuing space.
- A stand-alone kiosk for guests' needs. This is also the place that staff can offer amenities and give rules for each particular exhibition.



Featured Exhibition: Amenities

- In partnership with Cincinnati State Interpreter Training Program, each featured exhibition will have at least one “Deaf Day” with ASL interpreters on hand to facilitate conversations between guests and CMC floor staff.
- When audio guides are offered in a featured exhibition, a scripted version of the audio guide will also be available for purchase from Guest Services staff.
